What to expect from the NABNW: We will come alongside the local church to assist in the following areas:

- 1. Strengthening the Disciple-Making Health of the Local Church: The NABNW will come alongside the local church to help assess health, provide consultation, coaching, and tools to strengthen the disciple-making health of the church.
- 2. Developing Leaders: The NABNW is committed to coming alongside the local church to help in the development of leaders in the local church for the local church. The region has developed the Cascade School of Theology that is a partnership with Sioux Falls Seminary to provide master's level theological training for pastors, church planters, missionaries, and gospel workers of all kinds that is affordable and in the context of the local church.
- **3. Church Planting:** The NABNW will come alongside the local church to provide guidance, training, assessment, and resources in planting new churches. The NABNW will develop and resource ethnic ministry toward the vision of multiplying ethnic congregation throughout the region.
- **4.** Caring for Pastors: The NABNW will come alongside the local church to care for, encourage, and equip pastors and elders to effectively shepherd the local church.
- **5. Strategic Partnerships:** The NABNW will seek strategic partnership with likeminded churches and organizations, creating synergy for the mission that we could not generate alone, in order to accomplish the mission God has given our region.
